Big Heart Donations

- **Transport Vehicle** – Good condition van or utility vehicle for safely transporting animals to and from offsite locations. This will let us bring more animals to more adoption locations and events and will also assist us in medical transportation and picking up donated items! Get a tax deductible donation while helping save lives!
- **Laptop or Desktop Computers & media accessories** – For remote volunteers to assist in administrative and outreach work, web marketing, postings, social media, grant writing, etc.
- **HD Digital Video Camera** – We desperately need modern photo equipment that includes the ability to make videos of the rescued animals in our care and footage of events and successes, for web exposure purposes that will greatly increase chances of adoption!
- **Room Air Purifiers** – Good quality room air cleaners will help make a cleaner environment all around!

Additionally, we will be holding our first [Catz Jazz Annual Halloween Arts & Crafts Benefit](#) in which we are collecting event auction and raffle items such as **original artwork** and **handcrafted items** donated by local community artists and crafters who want to direct their successes towards helping us out in a mutually beneficial relationship where we will reciprocate a charitable spirit by offering public exposure. Catz Jazz Rescue is an all-volunteer 501(C)3 NON-PROFIT Texas-based companion cat rescue group serving the Austin area established with a mission to provide safety, shelter, veterinary care, medical rehabilitation and socialization for abandoned or abused cats (and sometimes dogs) until good permanent homes can be found for them. We do not maintain a paid staff; our foster, resource and support network are funded exclusively through out-of-pocket contributions and community donations. All of the animals we take in come from hopeless situations, local kill shelters, cruelty cases released from law enforcement or from owner surrenders who no longer want their special needs or older cats and we also help keep feral strays from reproducing on the streets by participating in T-N-R and managed colonies.
